

## Actor's art at Art Trax

Keep your camera on hand – you might be in for a celebrity sighting.

Golden Globe and Emmy Award-winning actress Jane Seymour will be at Port Credit's Art Trax Gallery Nov. 5-6 to promote *The Art of Jane Seymour: 2010 Canadian Exhibition*.

Many fans are initially surprised to learn that Seymour, who's known for her role in the TV series *Dr. Quinn, Medicine Woman*, is a visual artist.

Over a decade ago, Seymour began painting professionally. She was even selected as one of the official painters for the 2005 Torino Winter Olympics and the official artist of the 2006 Naples Winter Wine Festival, the 2008 Beijing Olympics and the 2010 Vancouver Olympics.

At Seymour's upcoming Mississauga exhibit, art fans can view a collection of her original paintings, watercolours, sculptures and limited edition giclées.

According to Sue Black, owner and founder of Art Trax, Seymour's work "ranges from her joyous impressionistic Water Lily series painted in Giverny at Monet's garden, to vibrant florals and colourful landscapes."

Black adds: "Ms. Seymour does exhibitions all over the United States and was very interested in having an exhibition in Canada this year. We are absolutely thrilled that she has chosen to exhibit her work at Art Trax Gallery."

In addition, Art Trax is using the occasion to bring awareness to Milton's Darling Home for Kids, which fits with Seymour's passion for supporting many charities. The facility serves children with life-limiting or life-threatening illnesses who require complex care.

Art Trax will be selling and displaying Seymour's creations until Nov. 19. Her artwork ranges from \$1,495 to \$50,000.

Those who purchase her art before Nov. 5 might have a chance to attend an exclusive VIP cocktail reception on that same date, where Seymour will sign and dedicate early purchases. The reception will be held from 7-10 p.m. and attendance is by invitation only.

Art fans can also check out Seymour and her work at Art Trax on Nov. 6 from noon-4 p.m. Tickets for the meet-and-greet can be obtained through Art Trax.
